Correspondence, including letters from Skulason's father, G. Skulason, to his brother, Eirik Skulason, in Iceland, recounting pioneer life in Pembina County; address of J.F. Douglas given at a North Dakota Association picnic (1949) in Los Angeles, Calif., documenting the life of his father, James A. Douglas, and the Icelandic community of Mountain, N.D.; biographical information; documents and agreements,

pertaining to 1907 North Dakota House of Representatives; scrapbook (Mss 1500) containing information (partially in Icelandic) relating to Skulason's professional and political career and his unsuccessful candidacy for U.S. Congress in 1909-1910; and newspaper clippings.
