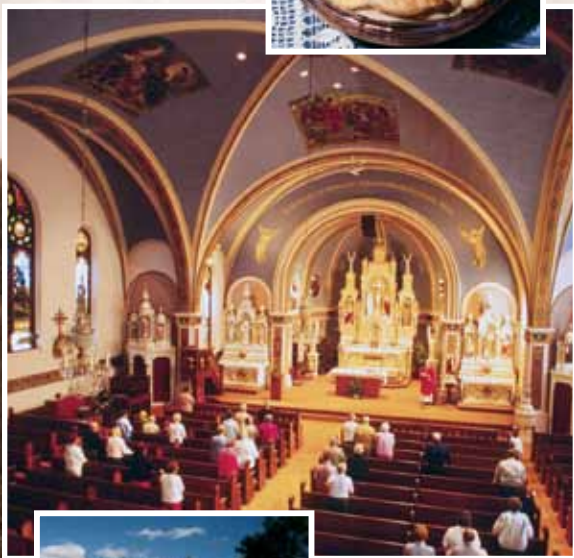

## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Tour registration is limited. However, we must have at least 40 tour members registered by Aug. 15 for the tour to be offered. If there are not enough registered participants, a full refund will be issued.

## COST

The cost for the tour is \$250 per person based on double occupancy. If you want your own room, it will be \$275 per person. All meals and lodging are included. Ethnic foods will be served on the tour including strudels, borscht, kuchen, plachenda, knoephla soup, homemade sausage, German potato salad and kase knoephla.

## REFUNDS

Should a reservation need to be canceled because of personal reasons of a tour participant, a full refund less a \$50 administrative fee will be made if cancellation is received on or before Aug. 1.
