Note: All dates in Russia are in the Old Style (O.S.) Julian Calander and the dates in the U. S. are in the New Style (N.S.) Gregorian Calander. For correct dates in the U. S., add 12 days to the Russian dates.

THE WILDERMUTHS

Wilhelm Wildermuth * 06 Sep 1864 in Lichtental, Bessarabia, Russia, and Christianna Zacher * 06 Mar 1867 in Neu Teplitz, Bessarabia were married in Lichtental on 24 Apr 1890. They had two children born in Lichtental: William * 22 Apr 1891 and Elizabeth * 02 Apr 1893.

Mrs. Wildermuth's mother was Elizabeth Reuter * 15 Aug 1839 in Teplitz, Bessarabia She married first husband David Zacher * 11 May 1838 in Teplitz on 01 Feb 1859 in Teplitz. He died on 24 Jun 1866, age 28 probably of the prevalent plague, Typhus (not Typhoid), or it could have been Diabetes which has struck one in every generation in our family: William W., Bill Frank, Nancy Jonietz, none in the next generation yet.

After David Zacher died, Elizabeth married second husband Gottlieb Bast who had a daughter, Friedrica (called Ricka) from his first marriage. All came to Linton, ND in the U.S.A. in 1894.

Search has been made for their names on ship lists about their arrival in New York, NY but their names have not been found on any shiplist. So far, no search has been made for their arrival at Philadelphia, PA which I now believe to be the arrival port.

I have reason to believe that Elizabeth (Betty) was about 11 months old upon arrival in the U.S. which would make their arrival in March 1894.

THE HALLERS

From the best data we have: Lydia (nee Haller) Wildermuth's grandfather, Georg Haller * 25 Apr 1856 in Bergdorf, Odessa, Russia married Magdalena Wolf. The best data we have about her birth date is 1860 or 1861, * in Bergdorf. From son, Peter Haller (Lee's uncle) we have her maiden name, "Muttie" (family nickname) for Magdalena. We already know that she was of the Wolf family. She was the first wife of Georg Haller. Death or burial date was supplied by Lydia's (Lee's) father, Johann Haller: died or was buried in April 1902 in Bergdorf.

Their children:

Johann Haller * 27 May 1887 + 14 Dec 1951 in Los Angeles, CA, age 64.

Peter Haller * 19 Jul 1891 + 24 Jul 1975 in Aberdeen, SD, age 84.

Lydia Haller (Mrs. Jake Fey) * 12 Jul 1897 + 03 Feb 1962 in Ellendale, ND.

After his wife's death, Georg Haller married a widow, Christina Dürr, nee Mehlhaff, who had four daughters. All came to Eureka, SD, U.S.A. on 17 May 1911 on SS Hannover, landing at the Port of Philadelphia.
