Born in Mahaska County, Iowa. Attended seminary at Baker University, Baldwin, Kan. Traveled in Europe and climbed mountains, including the Matterhorn in the Swiss Alps. Employed as a public speaker, lecturing on his travels and mountain climbing experiences. Pastor at First Methodist Church, Fargo, N.D. from 1891 to 1896.
