HISTORY

Kappa Epsilon fraternity was founded in 1921, when members of the pharmacy clubs at the University of Minnesota, Nebraska, and Iowa came together with the purpose to create a national professional pharmacy sorority. According to the Kappa Epsilon Professional Pharmacy Fraternity website, over 25,000 women have been inducted to the fraternity, 50 collegiate chapters have been chartered, and 21 alumni chapters have been founded. Currently, there are 43 collegiate chapters and 10 alumni chapters with active status.

On May 29, 1930 the Iota chapter was formed at the North Dakota Agricultural College. In the 1970s the Iota chapter at North Dakota State University was set at an inactive status. In the 1990s membership

began to decline in the fraternity. Around 2005, the Kappa Epsilon Iota Chapter dissolved at North Dakota State University.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Kappa Epsilon, Iota Chapter records consists of a series of administrative records, which include correspondence, reports, bylaws, policies and rules, budgets, pamphlets, attendance lists, information on the poison prevention committee, and several documents on the history of the Kappa Epsilon Fraternity. The records also include meeting minutes from 1961 to 2005. Scrapbooks from 1975 to 1990 (with some gaps) include pamphlets, newspaper clippings, and photographs, most of which are adequately labeled and described through the use of captions. A <u>Holy Bible</u> with lists of initiates from 1947 to 1995, a <u>Guest Book</u> from activities and banquets from 1956 to 2004, and a professional group picture of the members from 2000 to 2001 are also included.
