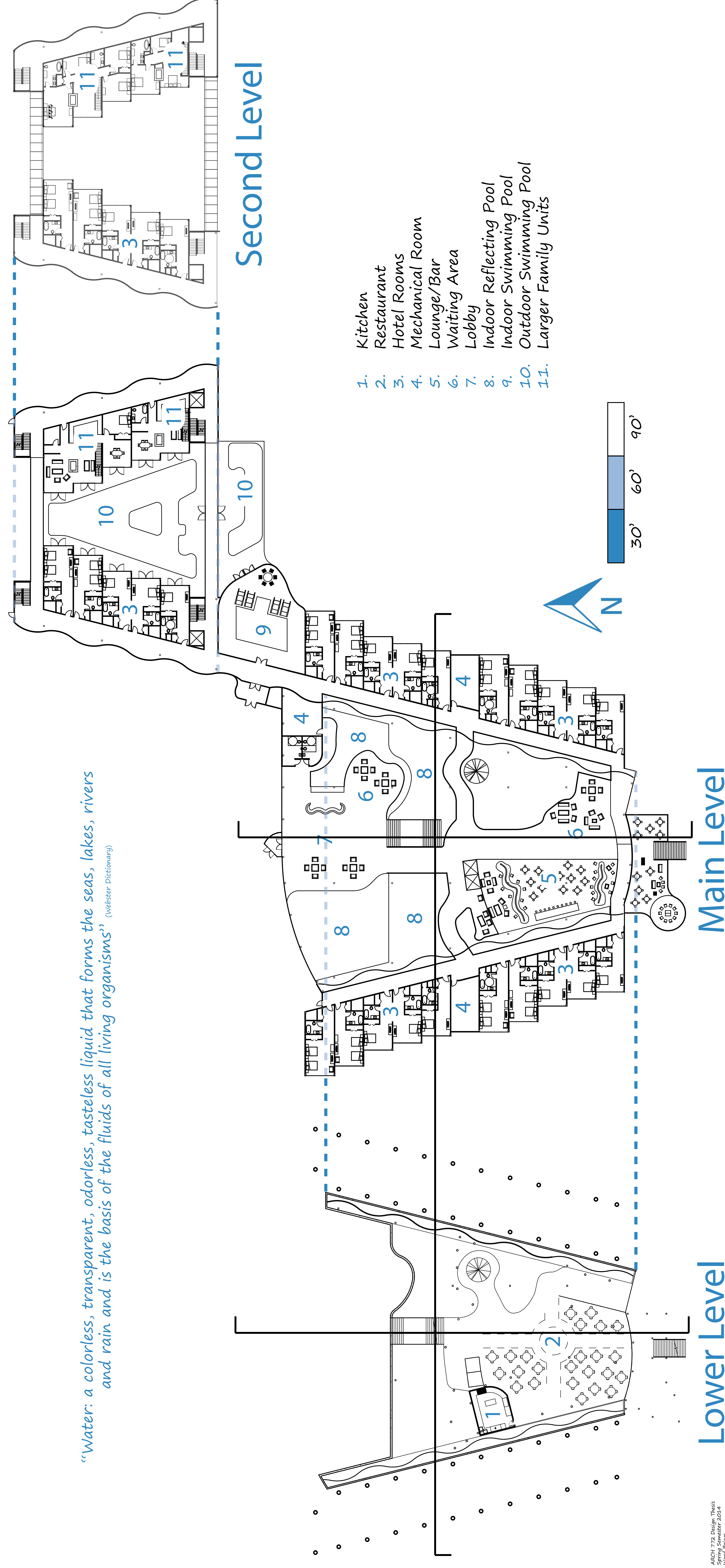

Seclusion is a valuable feeling that many people enjoy. This resort can accommodate the "hotel room" option for many guest located in the main building; but there are also twelve "isolated cabins" located throughout the property. Each cabin will have a bedroom, small living room, small kitchen and bathroom. There is a patio on the back side of the cabin with an outdoor shower; and in the front there is a deck overlook of a personal natural swimming pool.

The "hotel room" units for the main building are elevated above the ground. As the topography slopes down, the units stay at the same level. 1'-6" concrete pillars serve as the structure for the floor slab. Metal studs with sprayed-in insulation hold the sheathing to the underside for thermal protection. Above the unit is glulam beams holding up the green roof. A concrete metal deck serves as the base layer for the insulation, water membrane and soil. On the exterior of the wall is Western Red Cedar Shingles in some locations and Western Red Cedar Beveled Siding in others.
