### BIOGRAPHY

Hildred Shelland was born March 10, 1913 in Ada, Minnesota. Hildred attended North Dakota Agricultural College and graduated in 1935. She taught in North Dakota and Minnesota. In 1942, Hildred married Frank J. Long, and they made their home in Detroit Lakes, Minnesota. In 1977, they compiled a book together, "The Ancestors and Descendants of Adelbert David Carpenter".

Frank died in 1979. Hildred died on April 5, 1995.

## SCOPE AND CONTENT

The **Hildred Shelland Scrapbook** covers her college years at North Dakota Agricultural College from 1931-1936. During the conservation process, the scrapbook was split into two binders, part one and part two.

The scrapbook contains correspondence between Hildred and her family members, as well as letters from Dean Pearl Dinan. Also included are programs of various events, booklets, newspaper clippings, photographs, receipts, invitations to events, and greeting cards.
