In Agriculture At NDSU

Dr. Kenneth Gilles, chairman of the Department of Cereal Chemistry and Technology at North Dakota State University since 1961, was recently named to fill the new position of Vice President for Agriculture. The appointment was made by President Laurel Loftsgard. Dr. Gilles will coordinate agricultural programs in research, extension, and resident instruction, and in university extension. He was formerly project leader in charge of flour quality research for General Mills of Minneapolis.

Dr. John Callenbach, Associate Dean of Agriculture and Associate Director of the Agricultural Experiment Station at NDSU, will become chairman of the Department of Entomology, a position he held from 1953 to 1958 when he assumed his present position. He succeeds Dr. James Dogger, who accepted a position with USDA's Agricultural Research Service at Hyattsville, Md.
