

## MINING PAVILION

As the quarry with the most evidence of human activity, unique opportunities for understanding the process of granite mining are presented. Currently there is a giant crane hovering over, a remnant of the heavy equipment required for removing such massive, heavy rock.

Each mine starts with the removal of a small stone, and each of these are drilled to the depth of 10 feet. Thus the pavilion hovers over the emptied quarry at a dimension of 10 x 10. The orientation breaks from the imposed grid in order to frame a view of an especially visible St. Cloud Granite and Basalt intrusion.

With the water being emptied from the quarry, opportunities for experiencing the height from the pavilion, and bedrock from below are both presented.
