ARLON G. HAZEN, Assistant Director of the Agricultural Experiment Station since 1951 and Acting Dean of Agriculture and Acting Experiment Station Director since October 1956, is now Dean of Agriculture and Director of the Experiment Station. The change was effective May 1, 1957.

Director Hazen came to North Dakota in January 1946 as irrigation engineer for the Irrigation Experiment Station at Williston and was advanced to station superintendent in October 1946. He is an authority on irrigation. The new director is a native of Oklahoma, has a B.S. degree from Oklahoma A & M College and has an M.S. degree from Iowa State College. He was an instructor and did research at the University of Arkansas and Iowa State College before coming to North Dakota.

Dr. JOHN A. CALLENBACH, Experiment Station Entomologist since 1953, was appointed Associate Dean of Agriculture and Associate Experiment Station Director, effective May 1, 1957. Dr. Callenbach continues as Head of the Entomology Department.

The Associate Dean and Director was born in New Jersey, attended high school in Virginia and has B.S., M.S. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Wisconsin. He was entomologist with Montana State College and the University of Idaho before moving to North Dakota.
