BIOGRAPHY

Born at Milwaukee, Wisc., ordained 1913. Studied in Europe after World War I, taught at St. Francis de Sales Seminary, named Bishop of Fargo (1935-1959). In 1946, named Apostolic Visitor, and went to work in Germany with refugees. Later named Archbishop. In 1959, he was invested into the College of Cardinals. Died in Europe.
