



01 **1:540000"** Glacier National Park was established on May 11, 1910. There are 175 mountain peaks, 762 lakes, and 2,865 miles of streams in the park.

02 **1:420000"** In 1850, the park had 150 glaciers. Today only 25 remain large enough to be considered functional. It is predicted that by the year 2030 the park will be without any active glaciers.

03 **1:360000"** Alluvial soils (formed by water movement) comprise 3% of Glacier's soils, wet soils less than 1% percent, glacial and landslide soils 39%, and bedrock soils 55% of the total.

04 **1:300000"** Many Glaciers' belt rocks are Reddish-brown and greenish-gray in appearance, the rocks are comprised of argillite and quartzite material that was compressed under sea water to form mudstones.
