

As economic and cultural globalization and development continue to push forward, growing numbers of languages will become endangered and eventually, extinct.


With increasing economic integration on national and regional scales, people find it easier to communicate and conduct business in the dominant languages.

If architecture cannot-only remind us of these disappeared languages, but also triggers mental reconstruction for future generations, like a reminiscent of the traces through time. Cultural artefacts are still alive in many cultures, like a Palimpsest, indicating the layering of stories, fragments, and traces which will help to better understand the transformation and history of their origin. Narratives that have already begun to fade somewhat, but they are still noticeable.

Thus, perhaps architecture can be the narrator of the stories (some untold) that we once knew by highlighting the forgotten, In order for it to be absorbed in one's thoughts.





The Royal Library of Alexandria in Egypt, was one of the largest and most significant libraries of the ancient world.
