

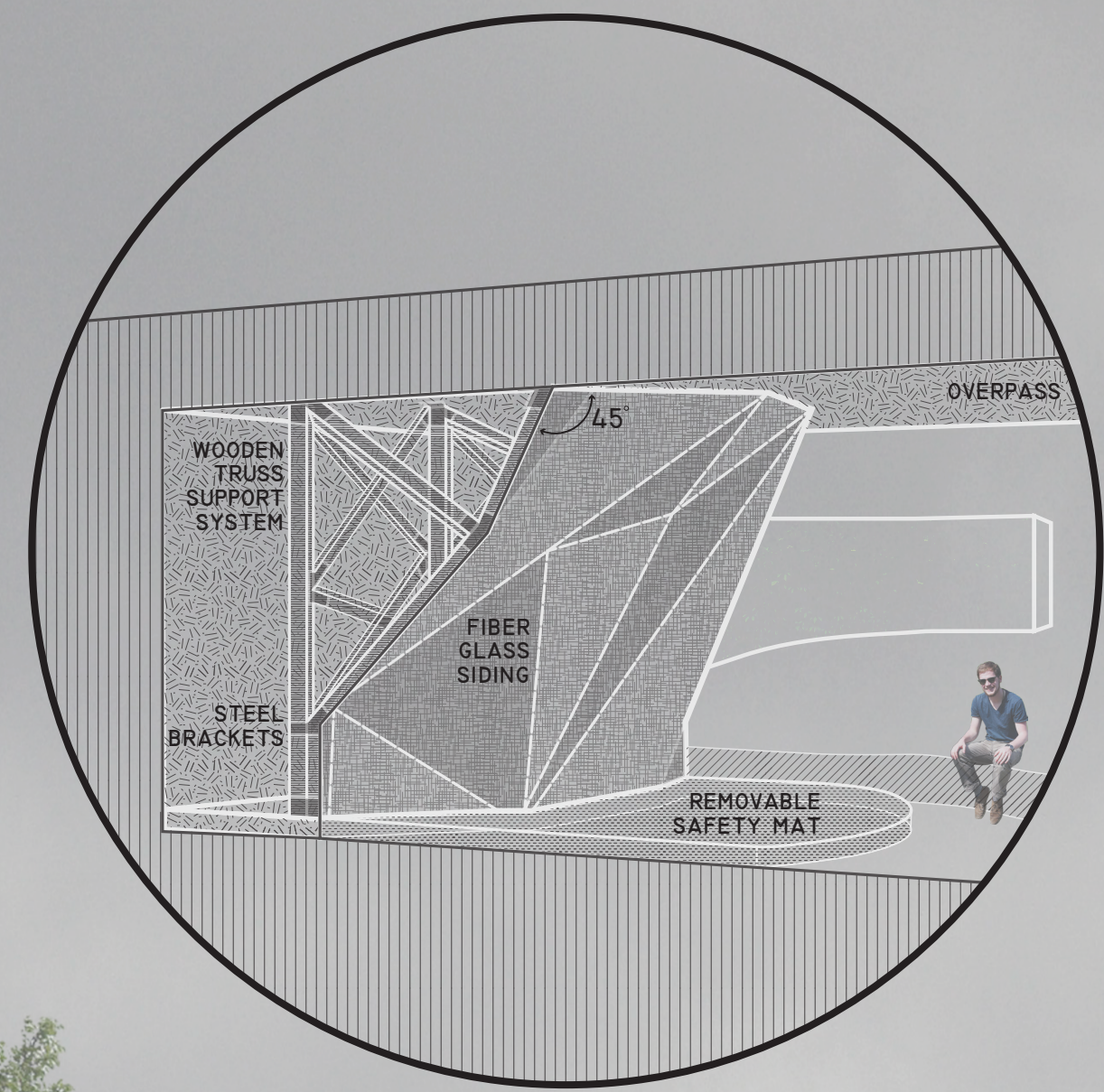

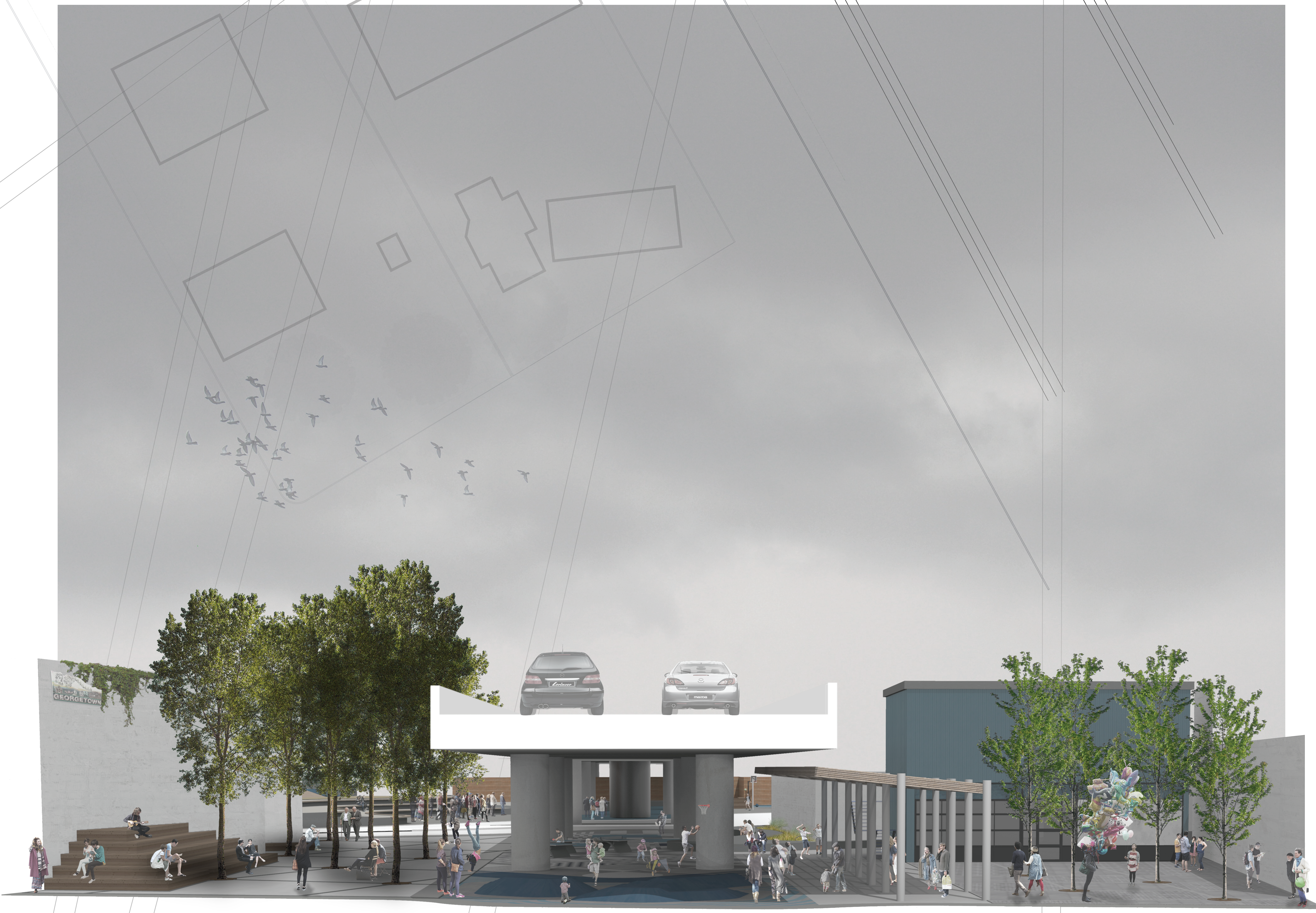
SITE PLAN 1:20

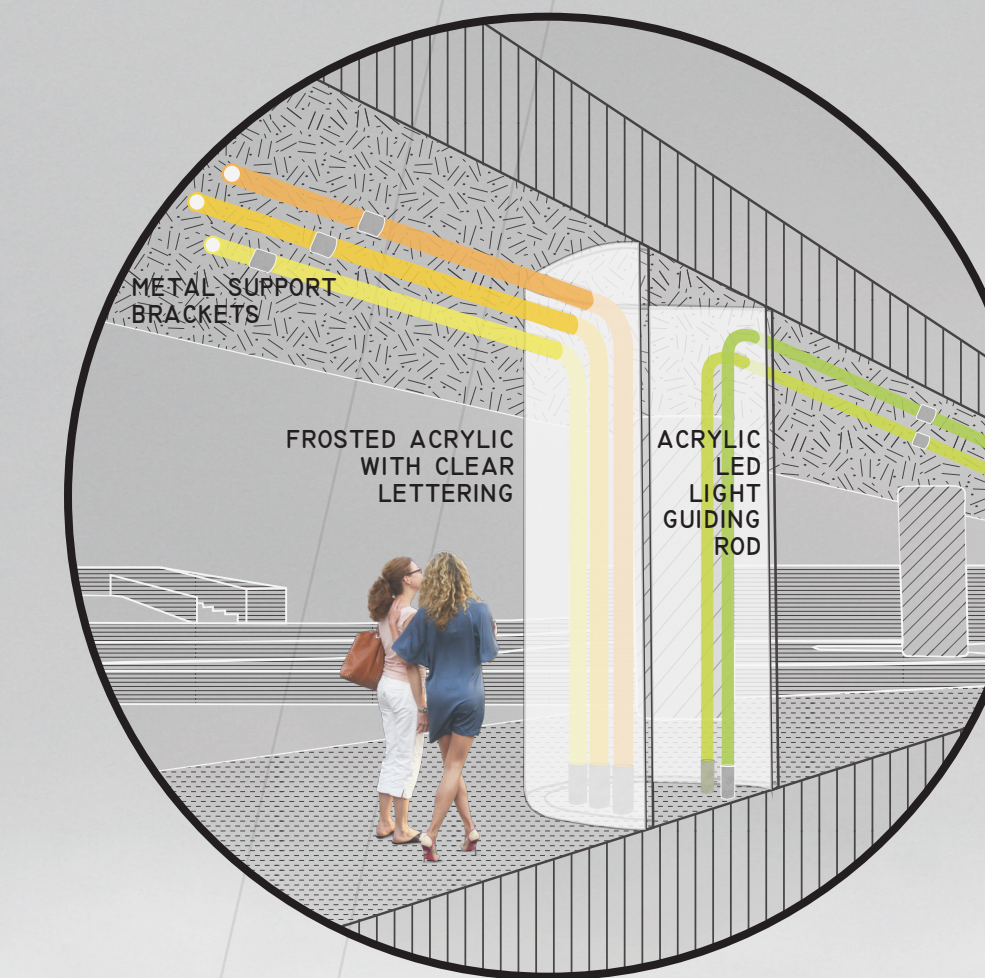

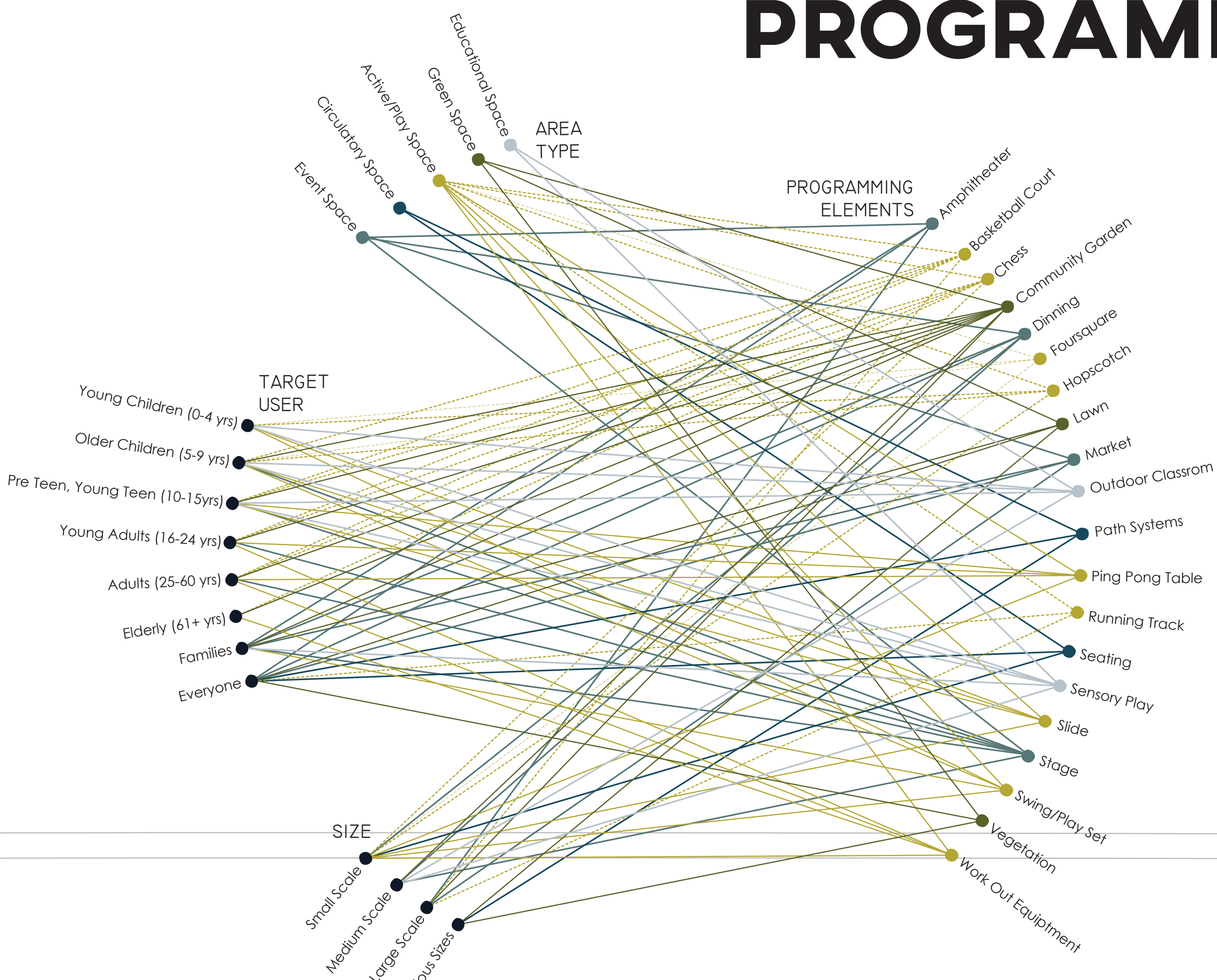

LIGHT TUBE WAY FINDING DETAIL

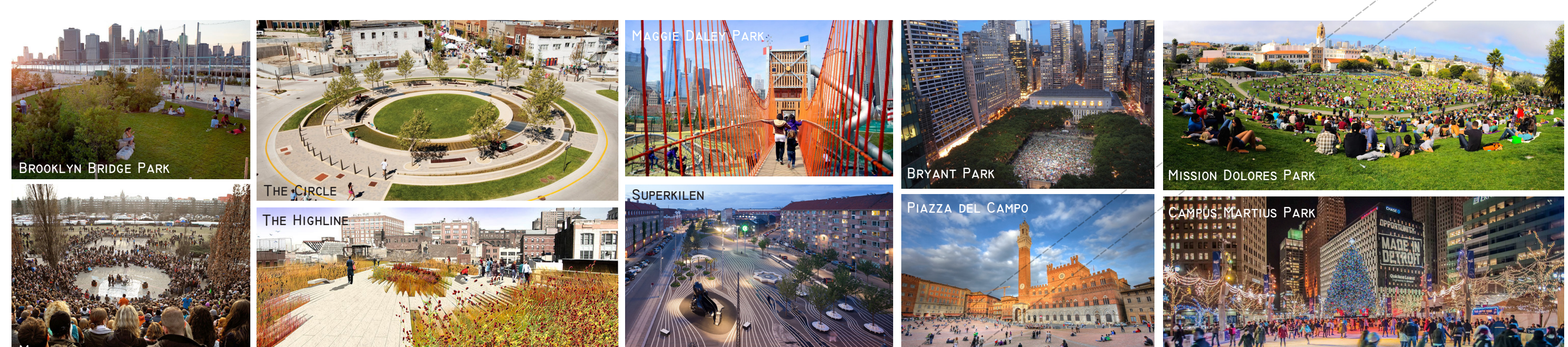
SOCIAL PROGRAMMING



WHEN DECIDING WHERE PROGRAMMING ELEMENTS SHOULD BE SPATIALLY, I HAD TO LOOK AT SOME CONTRIBUTING FACTORS. FIRST BY BRAKING IT DOWN INTO TYPE, USER, AND THEN SIZE I WAS ABLE TO MAKE SURE THAT A VARIETY OF OPTIONS FOR EVERY CIRCUMSTANCE IS COVERED. SOME OF THE OTHER FACTORS I LOOKED INTO WERE, WHAT IS MANDATORY TO WHAT I AM WANTING TO ACHIEVE AS FAR AS BRINGING PEOPLE TOGETHER. 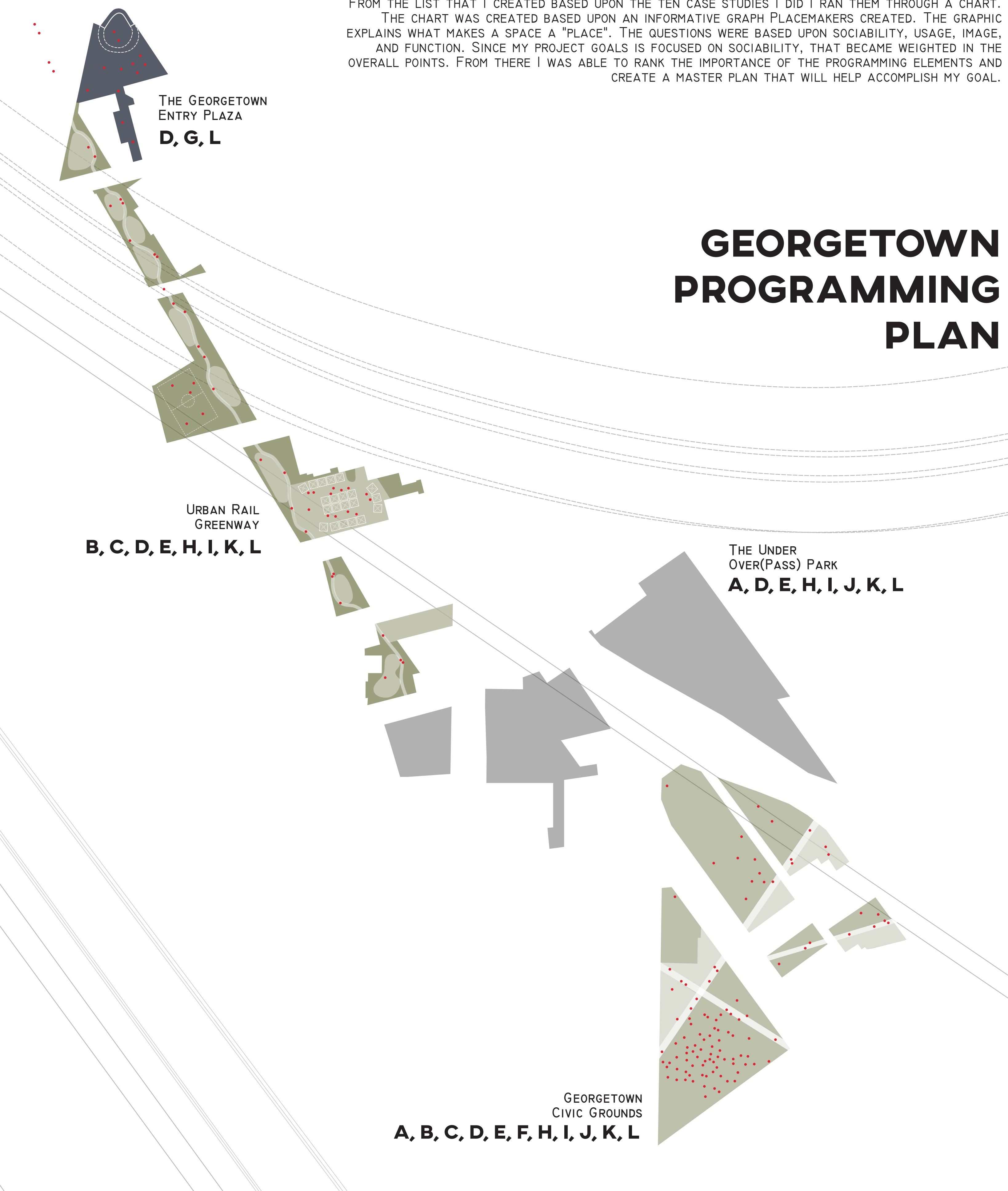

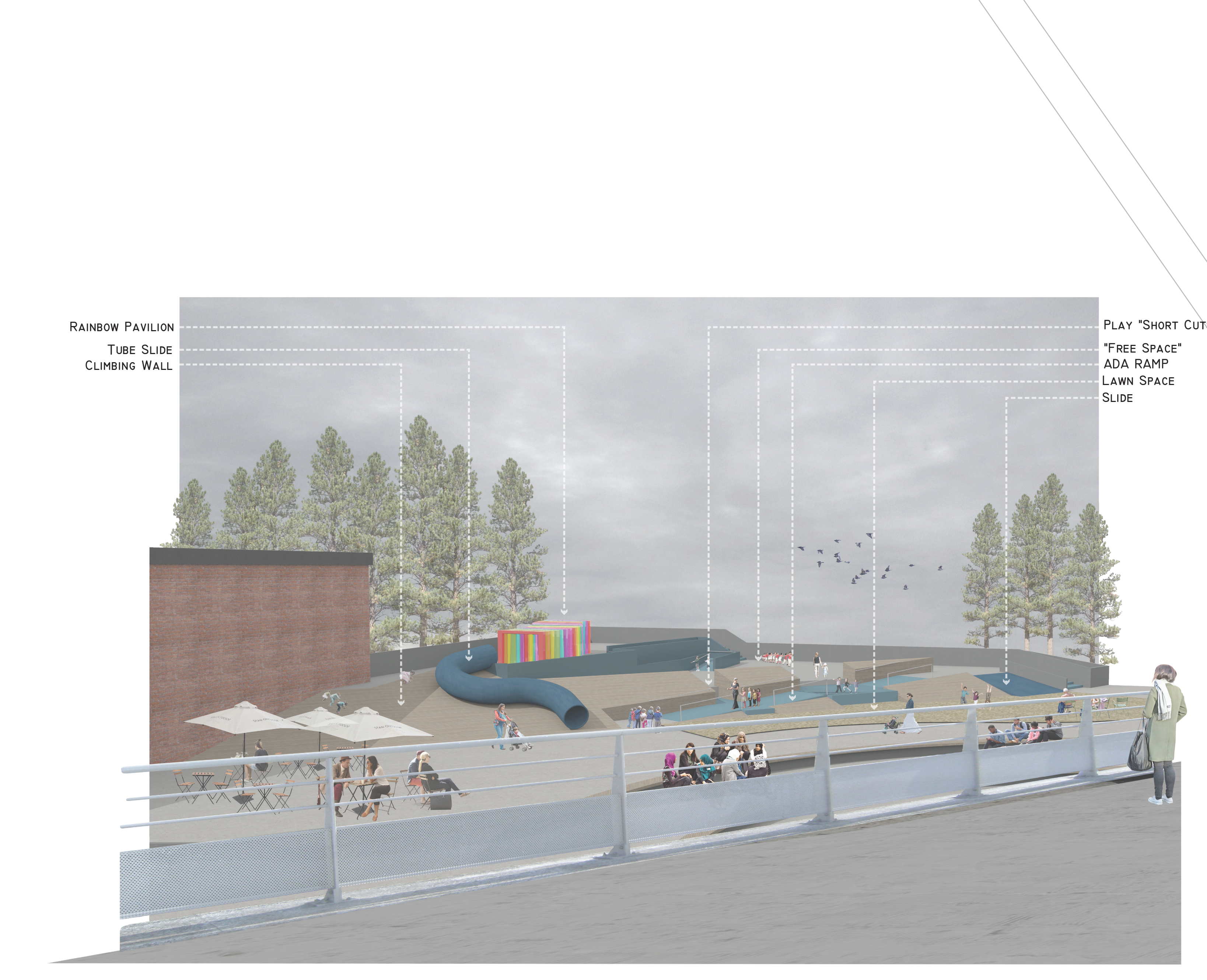
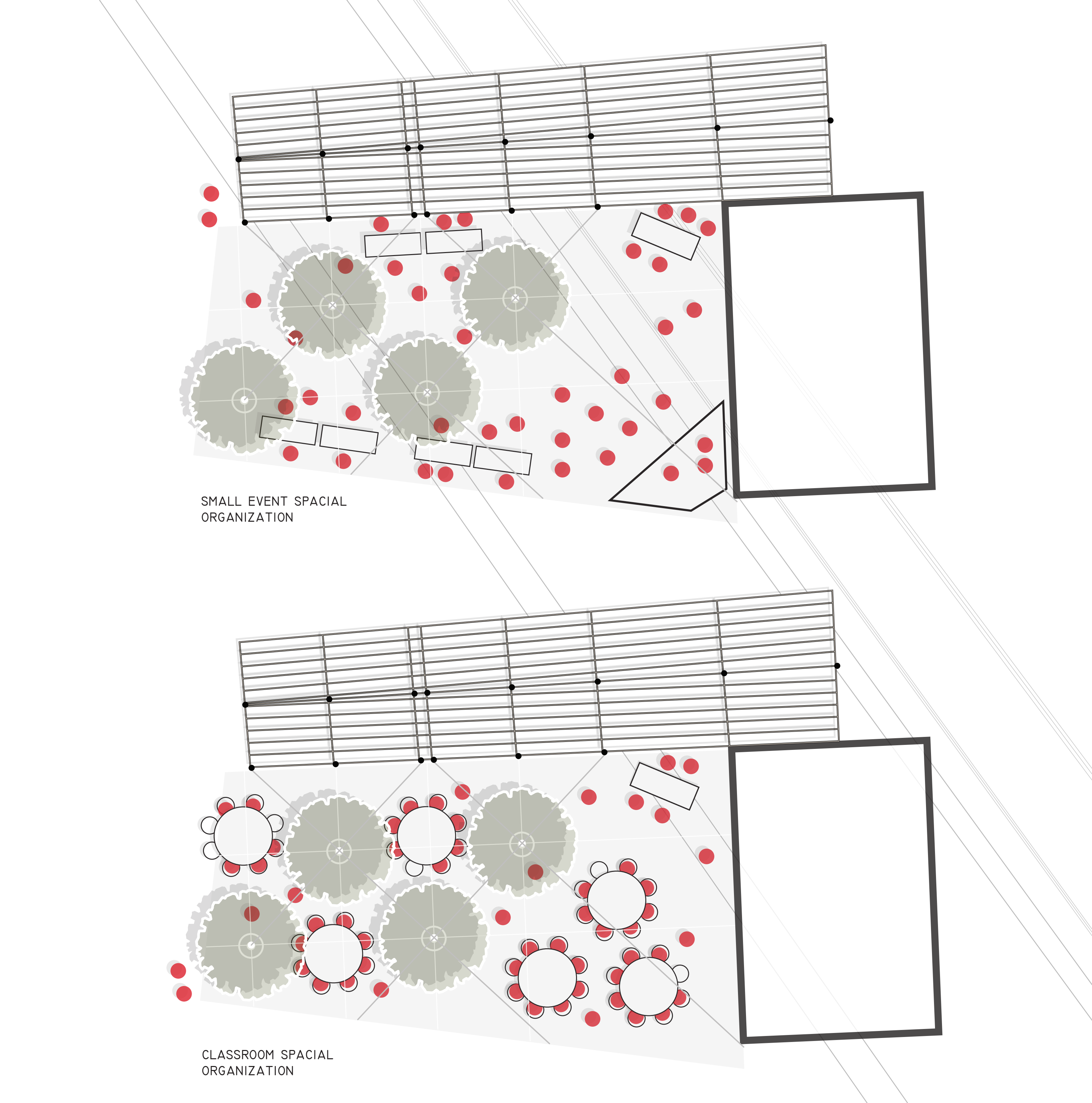
