George Jundt grew up in the Towner, Berwick, Rugby area. He moved to Minnesota to teach in 1963, and was a professional accordionist, and entertained five days a week in senior centers, nursing homes, and private parties. There is a newspaper article on George Jundt's great relative who immigrated from Speier, South Russia (Ukraine) in 1900, to Buenos Aires, Argentia then immigrating in 1904 from Argentina to Mandan, North Dakota.
