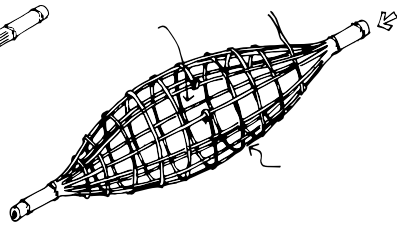
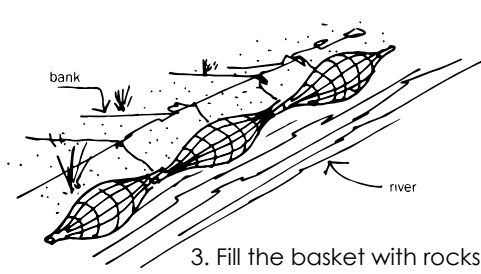


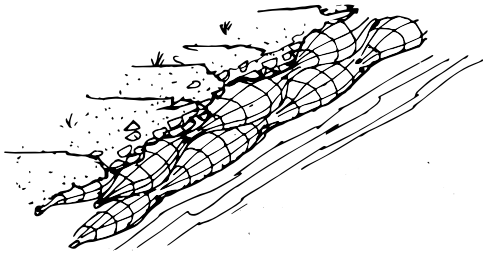
1. Cut bamboo into strips, leaving the ends solid.



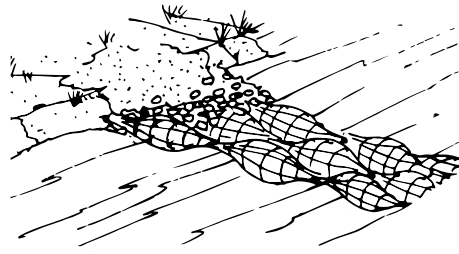
2. Push in the sides and weave strips around to make a basket. Leave one side open.



3. Fill the basket with rocks through the opening and place on the riverbank.



4. Make rows with the baskets and fill with rocks and earth.



5. The bank is retained and this method can also be used for dams.
