This is a message from North Dakota State University.

This message is to inform you that we have had a presumptive positive case of COVID-19 identified within a member of the NDSU community. We are taking steps to work with the individual to isolate them from others and will be assisting the public health officials in following up with any others that the individual may have recently come into contact with.

In accordance with guidance from public health officials at the county and state levels, this notice is being sent to inform NDSU faculty, staff and students of this development. NDSU has encouraged social distancing for everyone that has been working on campus.

The University is working closely with the public health officials who have familiarity with the case to follow guidelines to ensure the safety and health of the campus community.

This is not a time to panic. It is, however, a time to be attentive, flexible, serious, and engaged regarding the steps we need to take as a community to care for ourselves and for one another. Please continue to maintain the practices you are following to minimize your risk of exposure:

- Engage in social distancing. Keep distance from others (about 6 feet).
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick.
