As you know, NDSU will continue to conduct classes online through summer session. With the COVID-19 interruptions expected to continue through the summer, the Libraries will move forward as follows:

- All Libraries' locations will remain closed to the public until we receive further guidance from NDSU senior administration.
- Virtual reference service and materials pickup service for NDSU students, faculty, and staff will continue, switching to summer hours after Spring Semester ends.
- After Spring Semester ends, staff members can start working on campus per their comfort level, with social distancing, hand washing, etc. strongly encouraged, as arranged with their immediate supervisor.
- If you are considering Libraries-related travel (in-state and out of state), please check with your supervisor for further guidance.
- Libraries Administration and LMC will start working to determine how to safely reopen our facilities to the NDSU community and the public.

NDSU expects to return to normal or near-normal operations by the start of Fall Semester; the Libraries' future actions and activities will be based on those of NDSU. We continue to monitor the situation and will share updates as they become available.
