AGENDA ITEM: Review of Minutes of Previous Meeting

The minutes from the 2/3/21 meeting were approved as written.

AGENDA ITEM: Dean Mocnik "State of the Library"

Building: Dean Mocnik reported the foot traffic in the Library is picking up as the semester is winding down. Seating at the Library is at approximately 50% of normal capacity.

Huron Consulting: Dean Mocnik reported he met with Huron Consulting for an exit interview. He noted the Libraries was not a part of the initial proposal as an area to be looked at in their strategic prioritization process but he felt it was important for them to do this and the Provost agreed. Huron did a comparison of land-grant institutions without a medical school and their final report found that the Libraries is funded at approximately 60% of other these compared institutions. Dean Mocnik indicated that this confirms what we have known and it is hoped their findings can help as the Libraries moves forward.

Special Collections Focus: Dean Mocnik announced that a focus on photo journalism is being put in place as a growth area for the Archives. He would like to see the NDSU Archives be known for their distinct collections of regional photographers' collections.

Recruitment: The Libraries currently has received permission to recruit for the Administrative Assistant position in the Admin Office. The position posting is currently live.

AGENDA ITEM: General questions/concerns from units

There were no questions or concerns noted.

AGENDA ITEM: Future Leadership for Committee

Andy Stark self-nominated himself for the chair of the committee and Joe seconded this nomination. There were no objections from committee members present and it was unanimous vote from the committee members present to have Andy be the chair of the committee moving forward.
