Arlene Weible -> All Participants: Thanks!

Sara Westdal -> All Participants: Timeframe for exhange software migration?

Janelle Breedveld -> All Participants: Is a potential future enhancement disallowing in bulk? Our selectives have had some tech issues in eXchange this year where their lists were duplicated numerous times, and it took a long time to mark each item as ~38quot;disallowed~38quot; individually.

Lisa Russell -> All Participants: We don't know how long it will take to work out to work out the remaining details before we can begin the software migration, but we are hopeful that it will be within the next couple months. We expect the migration itself to take 8-12 months.

Lisa Russell -> All Participants: Yes, one of the top priorities for enhancements is to enable bulk processes in several places. I believe that disallowing is one of them. We are also planning to be able to do functions such as ~38quot;Mark As Discarded~38quot; and other similar processess in bulk.

Janelle Breedveld -> All Participants: Thank you!

Lisa Russell -> All Participants: ~38quot; Mark as Kept~38quot; may also be one of the planned bulk functions, which would allow the selectives to remove duplicates in bulk instead of placing that burden on the regional.

Janelle Breedveld -> All Participants: That would be a wonderful option as well.

Janelle Breedveld -> All Participants: Lara, do staff typically try to respond to askGPO inquiries within a specific amount of a time?

Janelle Breedveld -> All Participants: Great, thank you

Cindy Etkin -> All Participants: I'll get that information to you, Aelene, and the slides.

Jen Kirk -> All Participants: I have also been taking notes for REGIL. I'll send them to you Arlene
