



The German word *Behandlung* means 'treating' people and 'handling' them with care. "Within it, one literally hears the word 'hand', the skilled and practiced hand that can recognize problems simply through feeling and touching the affected parts of the patient's body. 'Treatment' in this sense is something which goes far beyond mere progress in modern techniques (Gadamer 99)." In this sense, I believe architecture follows a similar manner.

By placing one's finger in the powdered pigment and stamping it in the region on the board that is specified below, a connection starts to emerge between the body, the architectural representation, and the understanding of the importance of atmospheric architecture in healthcare.

1. Open the small clear container and place your finger into the black pigment.
2. Mark your fingerprint in the specified area on the presentation board with the pigment.
3. Clean finger off with a wipe in the tall jar and place in the black can or trash.
