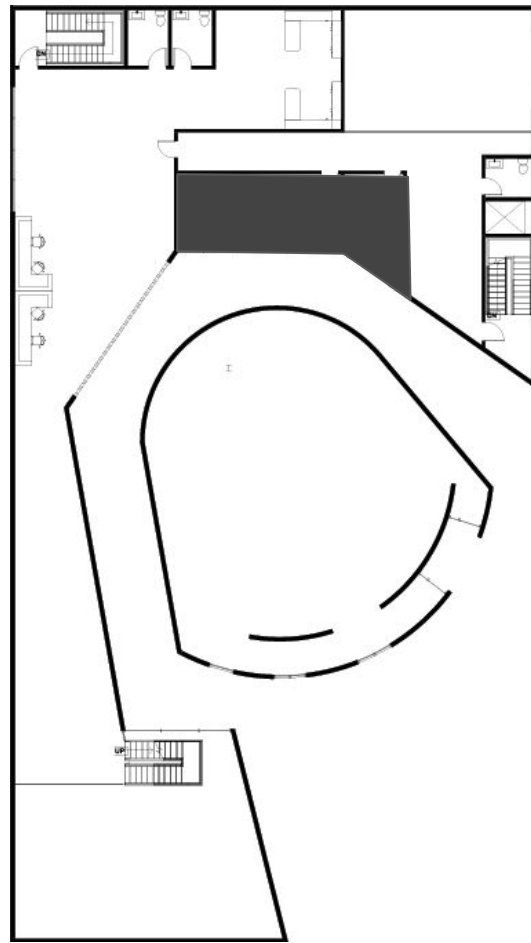




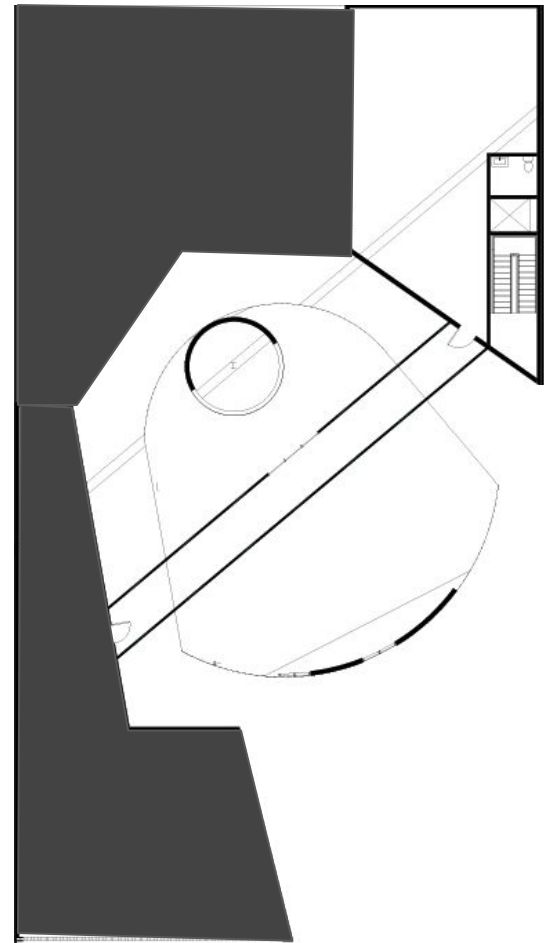




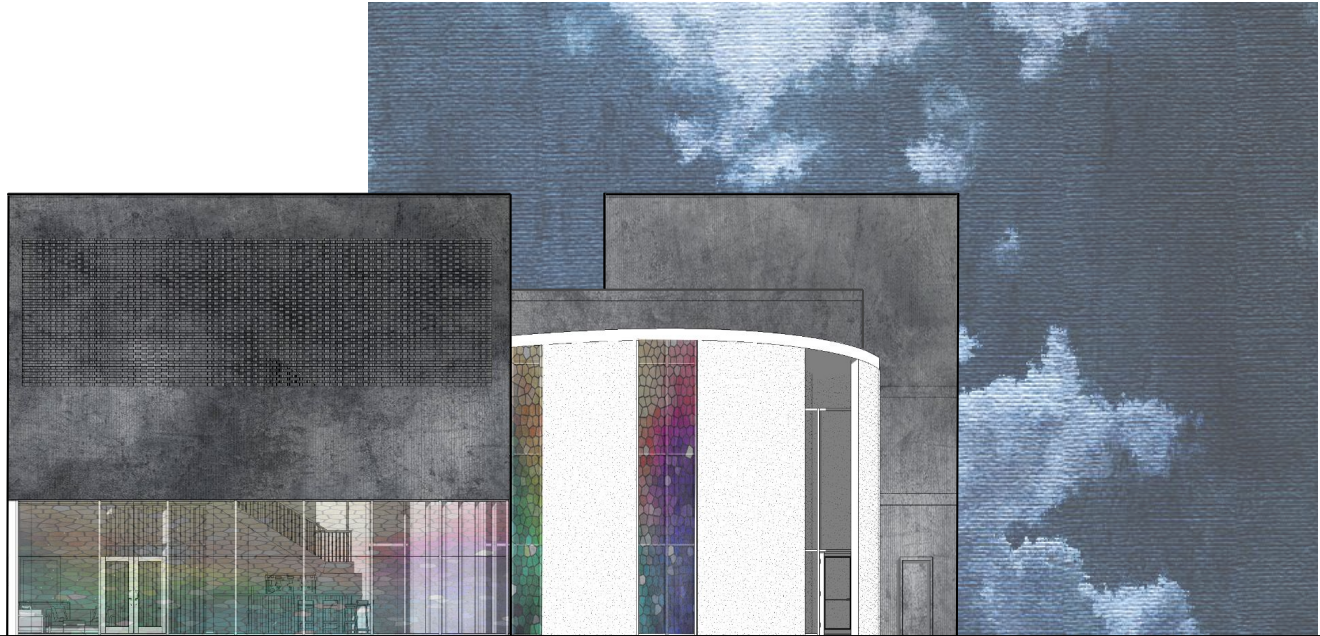
FIRST FLOOR PLAN

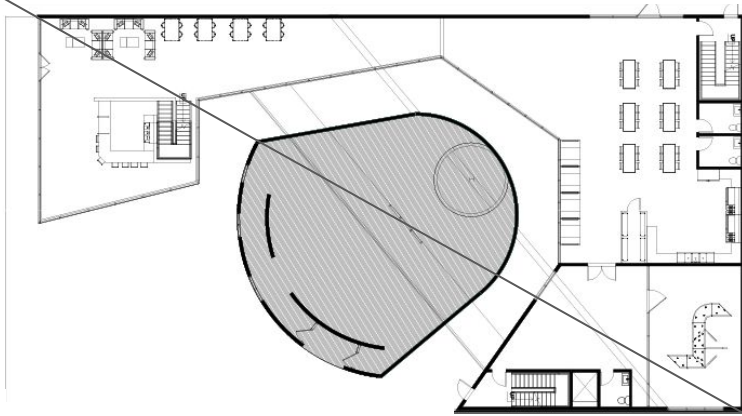

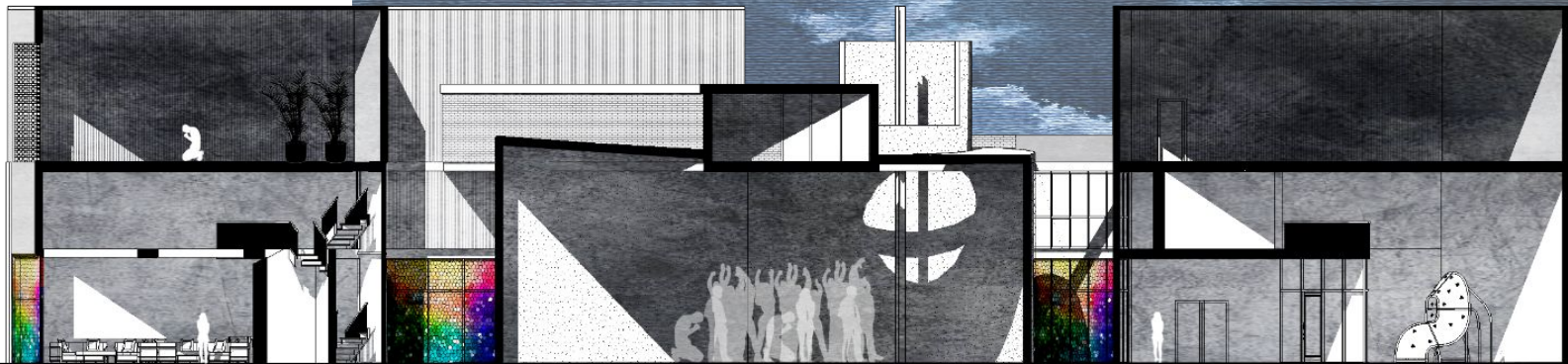
