### RESULTS OF AGE SEGREGATION

It can increase the risk of individuals becoming isolated later in life and prevent socialization between the young and old.

It can trigger a contradictory view of each other.

It does not allow for the creation of a generative society.

## HOW CAN WE BRING TOGETHER THE YOUNG AND OLD?

### WHAT ARE INTERGENERATIONAL SHARED SITES?

Intergenerational shared sites are programs that intentionally unite younger and older generations in a physical location with activities that bring them together.



### QUICK HISTORY OF I.G. SHARED SITES

One of the first known programs in the U.S. was the Foster Grandparent and Retired Senior Volunteer Programs created in 1965.

In 1986, Generations United was created to help improve the lives of youth and older adults through intergenerational programs.

These two programs have been leaders in the development of intergenerational programs around the United States and continue to advocate for the interaction between generations.

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These can include intergenerational building programs such as housing, community centers, public spaces, or care facilities.


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
This types of programs can share rooms, resources, staff and can be ran by the same organization or a different entity.
