




COMMUNITY SPACE ENLARGED PLAN


















IMPLEMENTING BIOPHILIC DESIGN

VISUAL CONNECTION TO NATURE

Benefits: Lowered blood pressure and heart rate. Along with improving mental engagement and attitude and overall happiness.



THERMAL AND AIR FLOW

Benefits: Positively impacted heart rate, systolic blood pressure, and sympathetic nervous system activity. Also positivity impacted concentration and improved perception of temporal and spatial pleasure.

MATERIAL CONNECTION WITH NATURE

Benefits: Decreased diastolic blood pressure, improved creative performance, and improved comfort.





OUTPATIENT MENTAL & SUBSTANCE TREATMENT Mindwell Heating Center offers outpatient levels of care for mental health and substance use disorders. Structured programming is offered based on clinical assessment and alleren needs. Programming is offered 5 days per week. The following three levels of care are ordered.

L: Partial Hospitalization Program (20 hours a week) 2. Intensive Outpatient Program (9 hours a week) 3. Recovery Maintenance, which supports individuals in sustaining progress post-program completion.
