





What is Story?


Noun- An account of imaginary or real people and events told for entertainment.

Object

- Weather Station Structure: the impression is one that it was seen somewhere in the wheatfields of the Midwest.
- Farm Land
 A cooperative supervised by the Farm Manager, surveyed by the Surveyor, policed by the Keeper of Scare Crows, advised by the Old Farmer in consultation with the Master Builder, and maintained by the Keeper of the Time.

Subject


- The Weather Man

- The Farmers














1st Floor




2nd Floor
