### ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY

The Medical Technology major is first found in the 1965-1967 bulletins, within the College of Arts and Sciences. By 1974 the major had moved to the College of Science and Mathematics. As of the 1996-1998 bulletins, the Medical Technology major had become Clinical Laboratory Science. This opened up the options for a registered medical technologist or a clinical laboratory scientist. The Clinical Laboratory Science major moved from the College of Science

and Mathematics to the College of Pharmacy, Nursing and Allied Sciences in Spring/Summer 2006.
