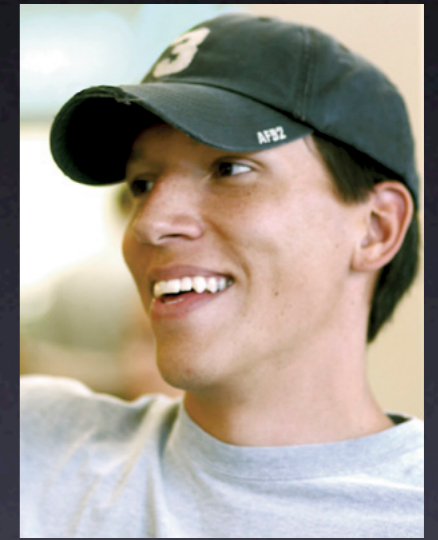

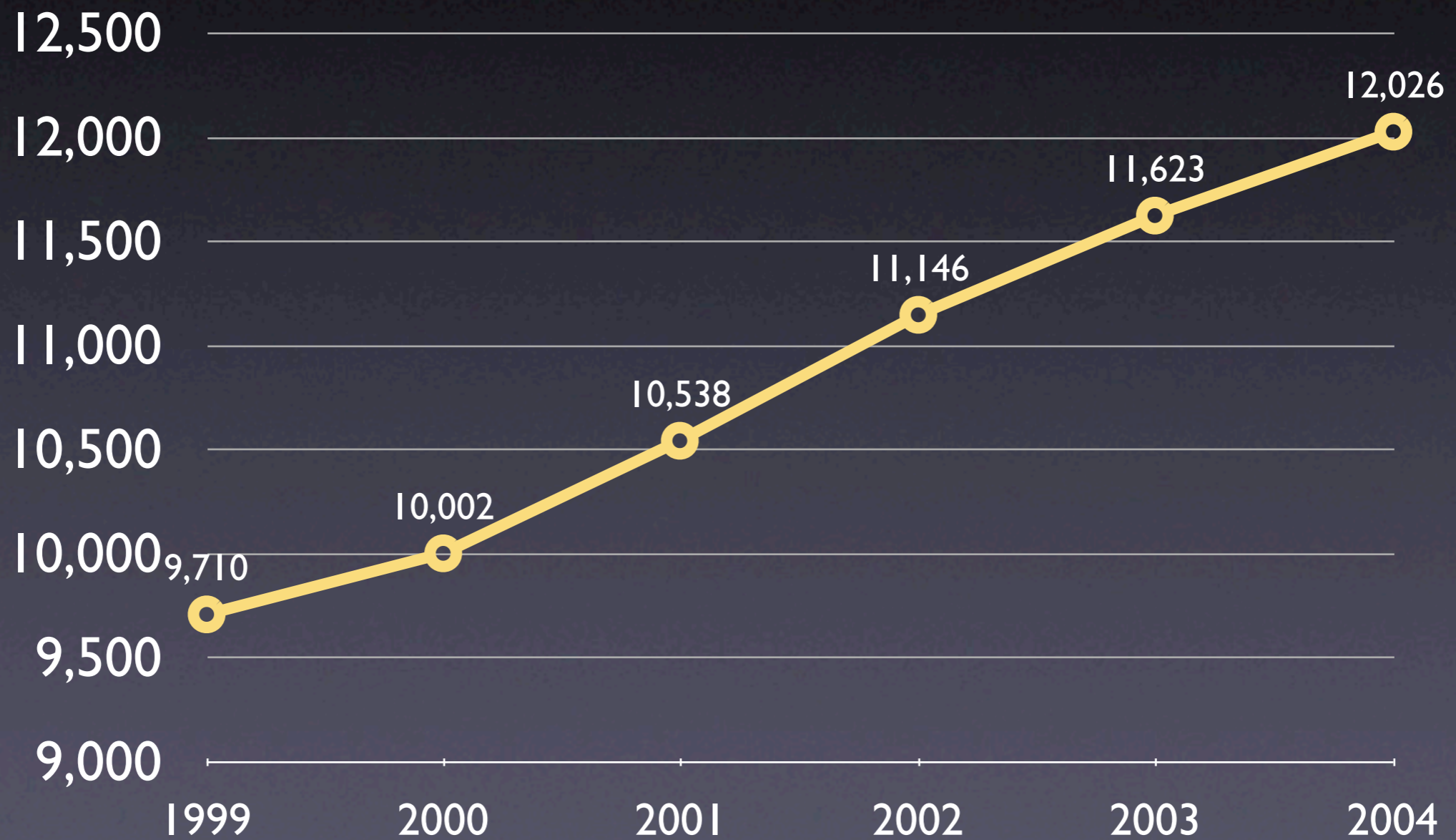

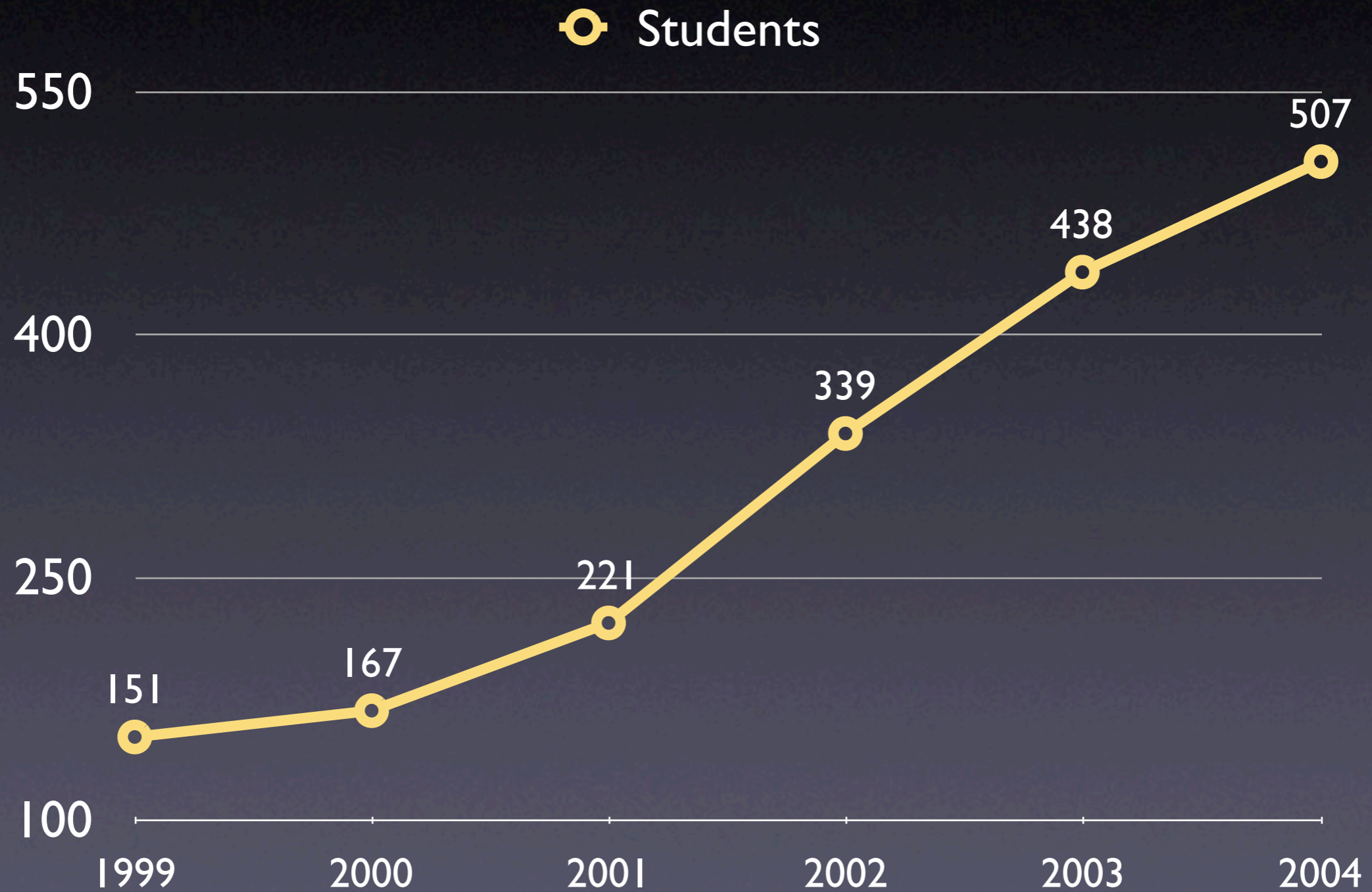


# Total Enrollment

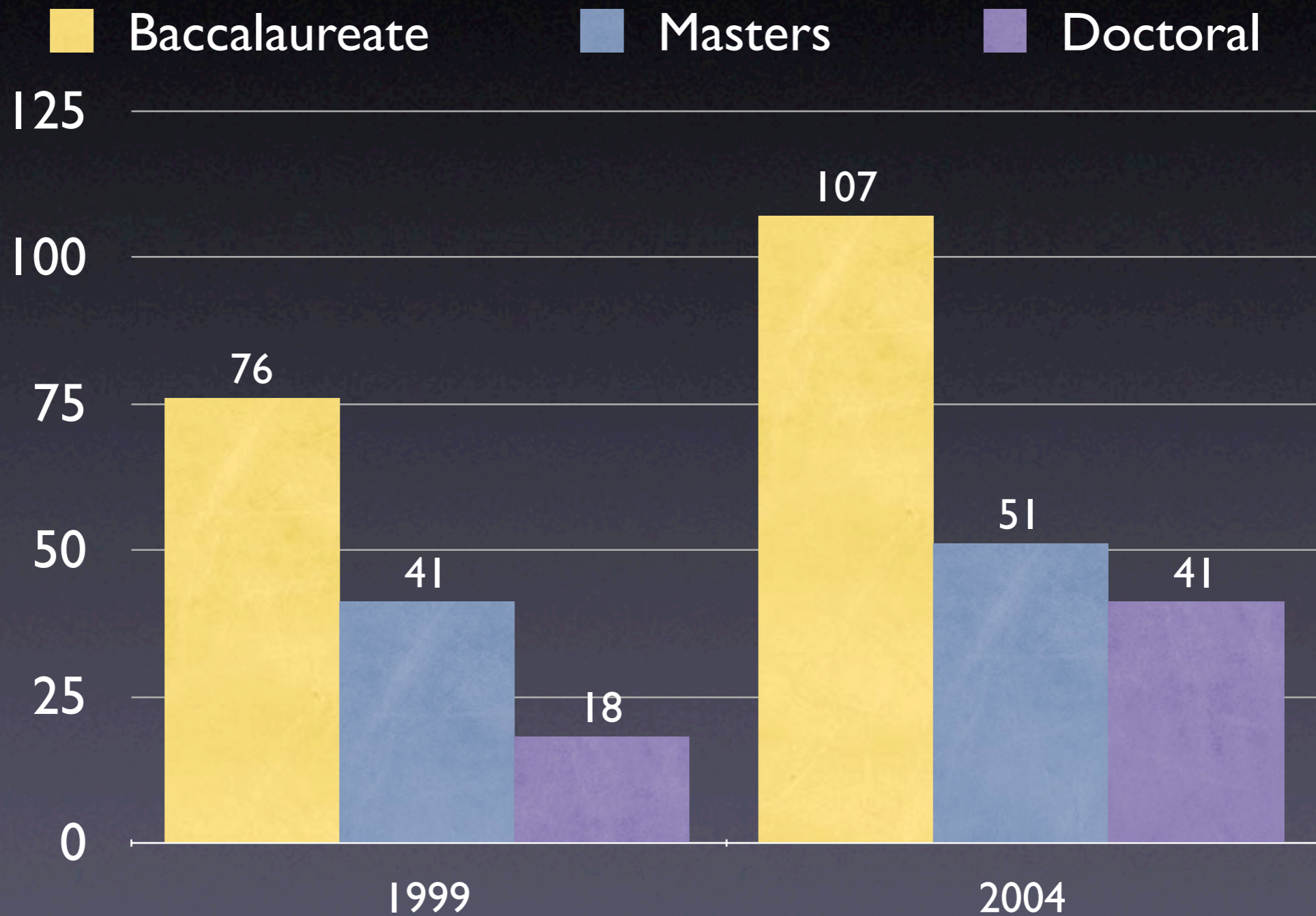

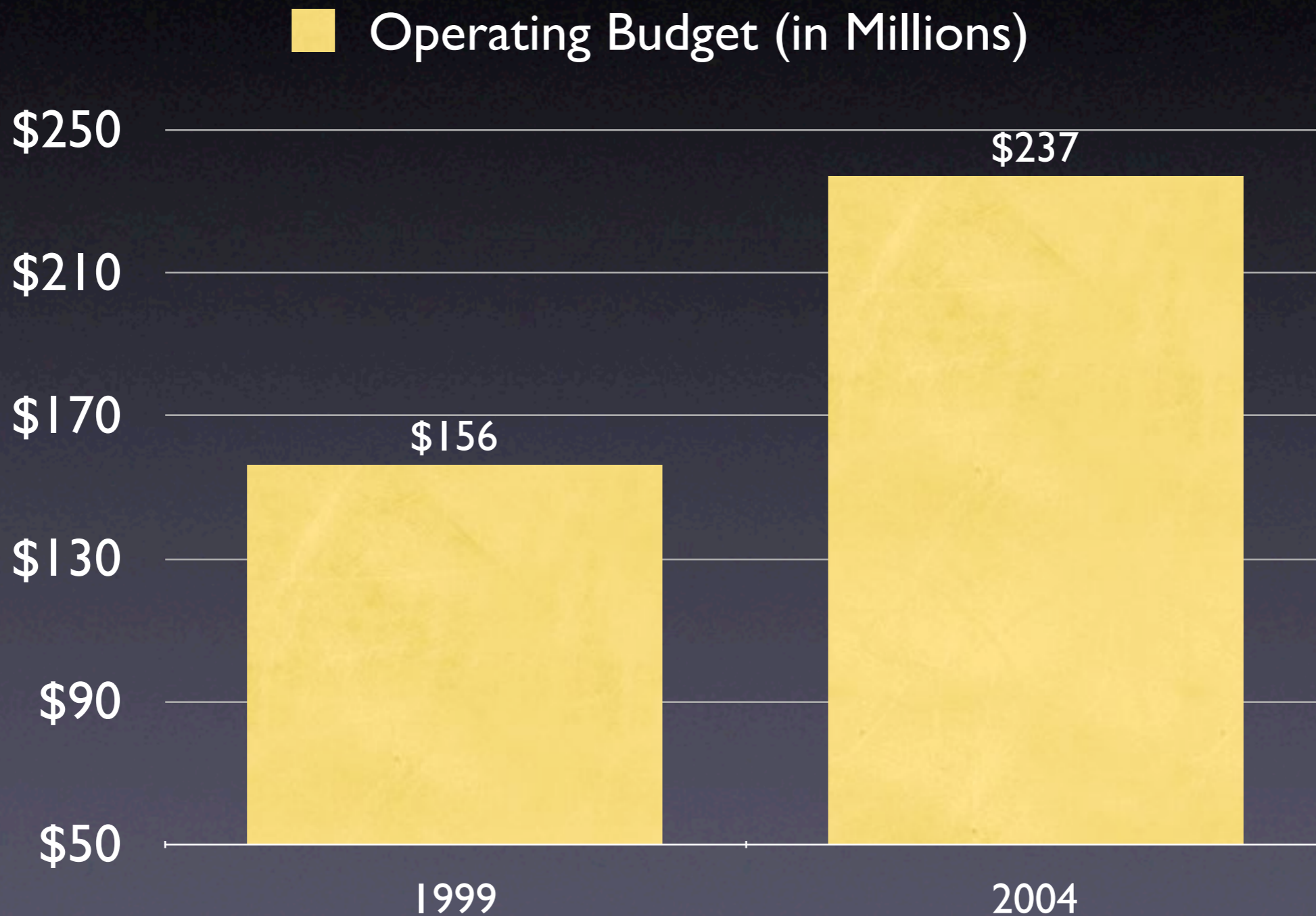

# Growth in NDSU Operating Budget



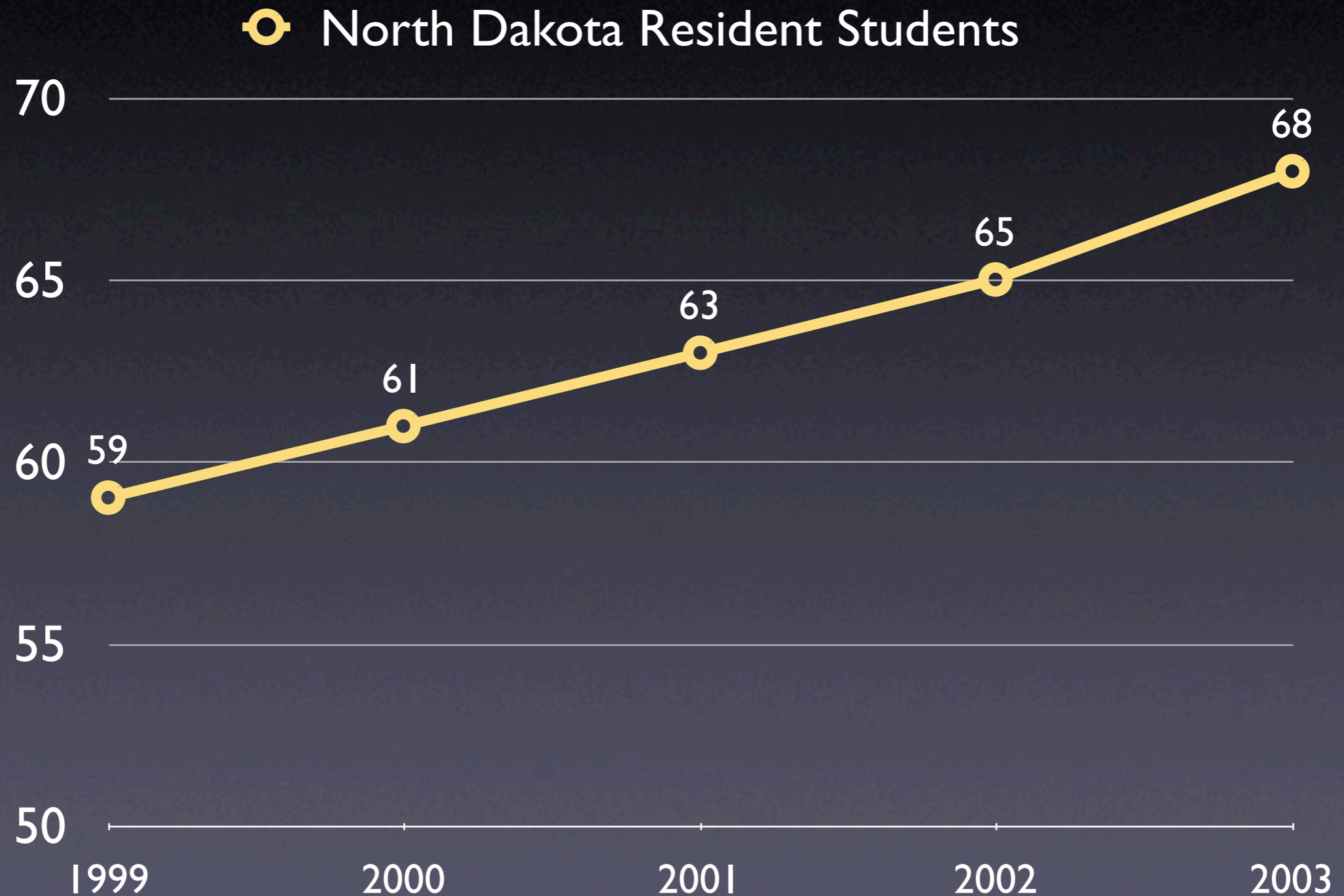
# Additional Tax Revenue

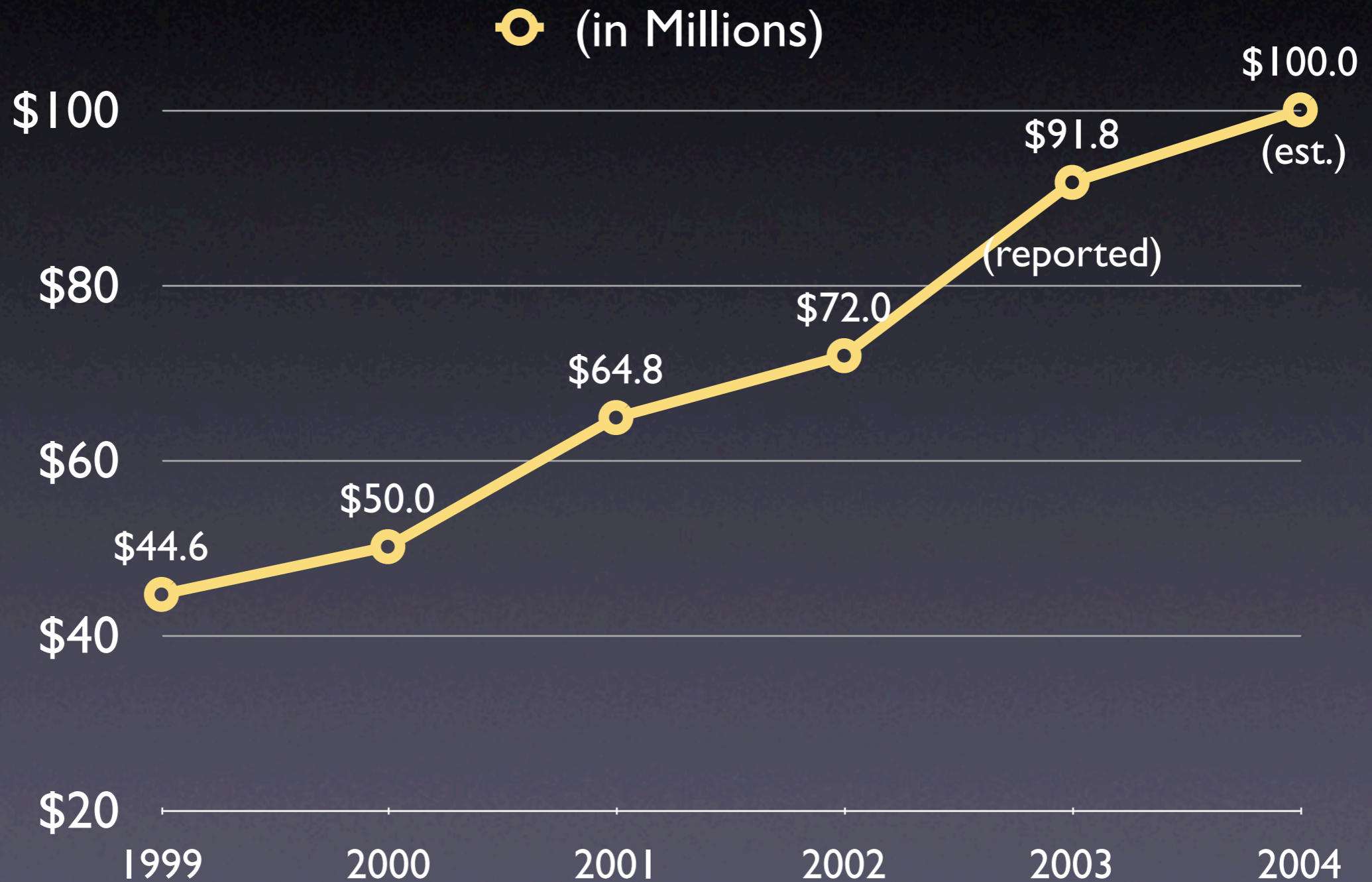
