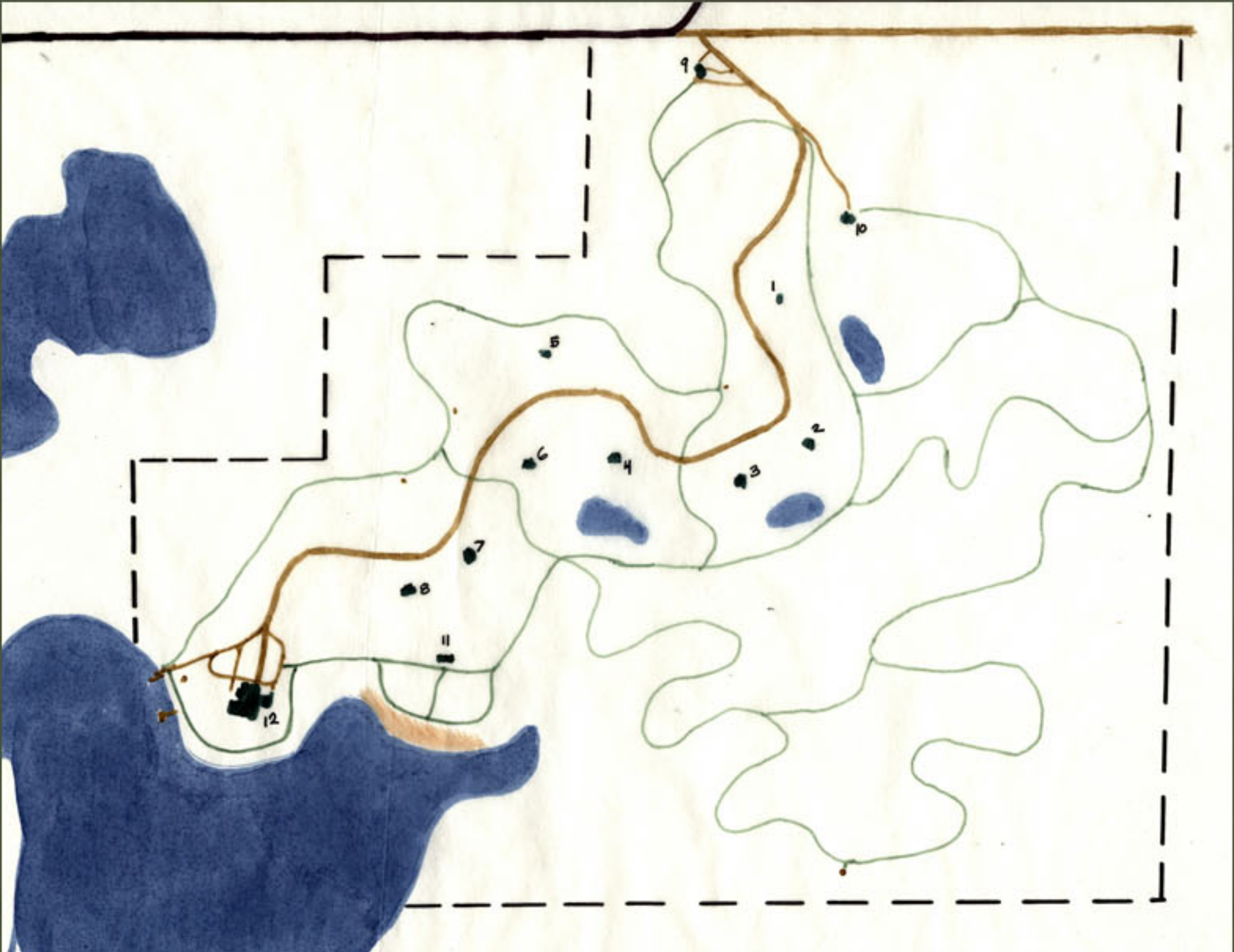
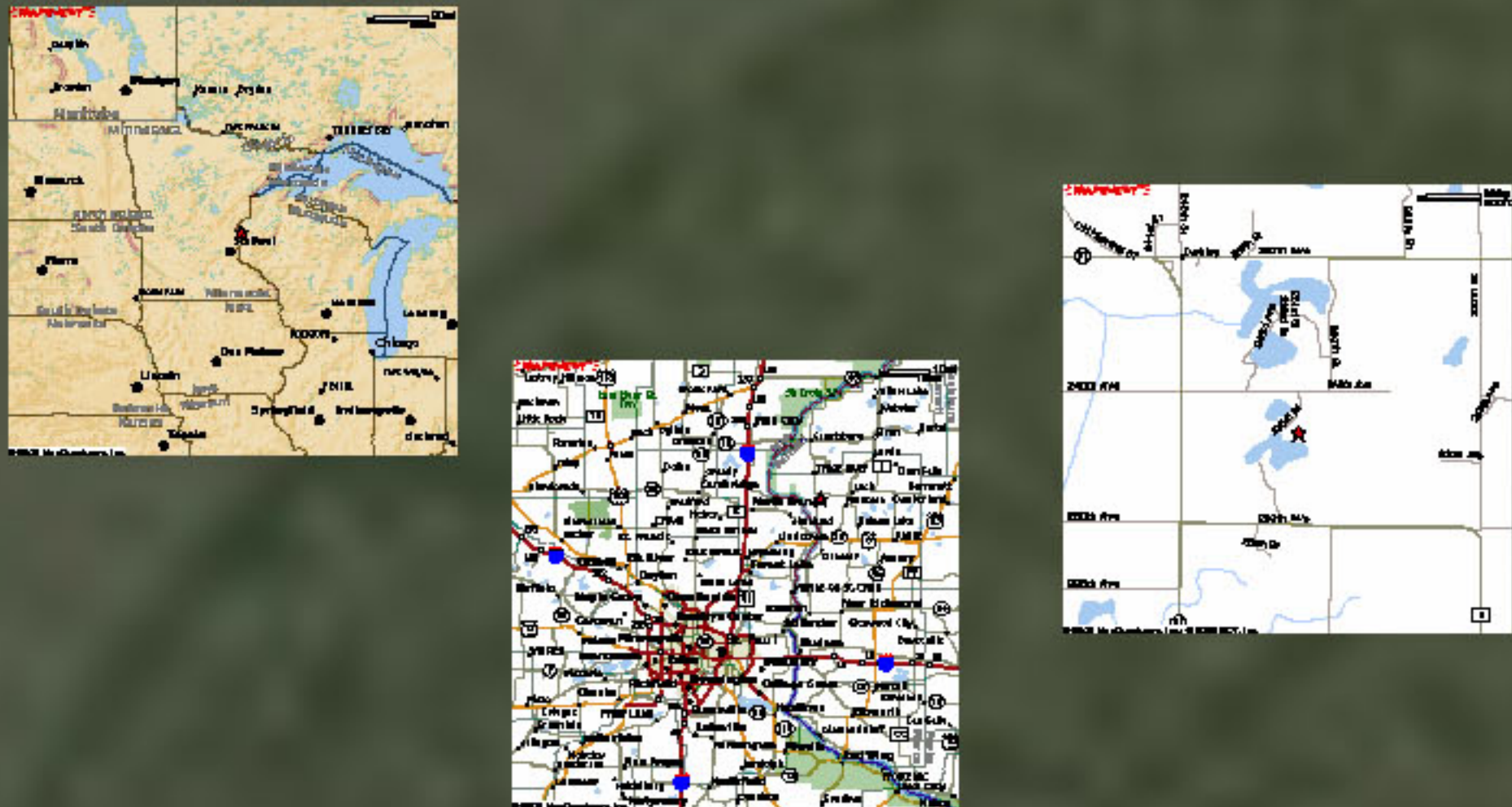

Site Plan

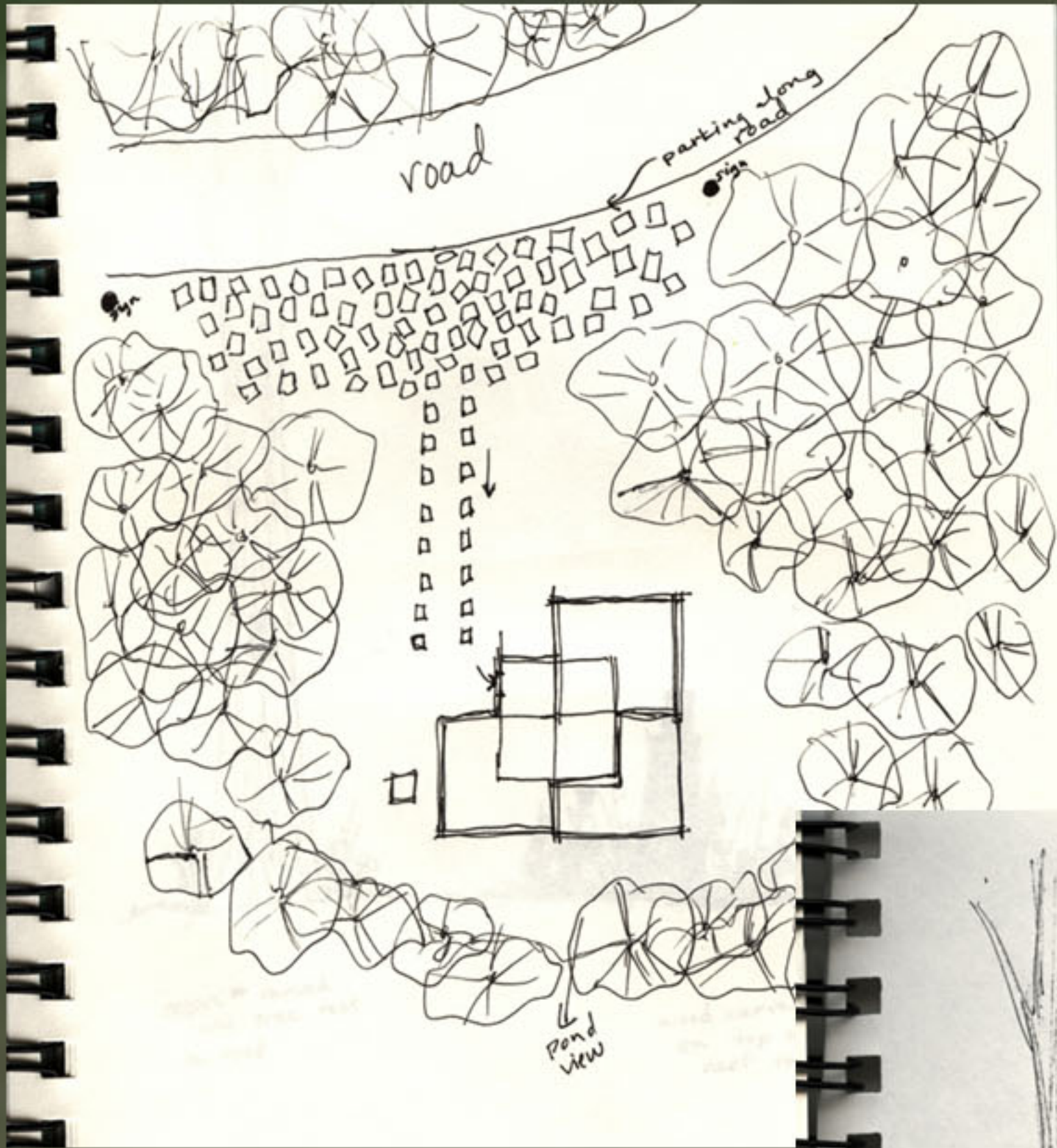


The site is located in Polk county, in what is considered the northwest region of Wisconsin, about 12 miles north of St. Croix Falls, between the small towns of Eureka Center and Cushing. It is about 52 miles northeast of the Twin Cities, and just one mile east of Wisconsin State Highway 87, which runs north from St. Croix Falls to Grantsburg, WI, on 240th Ave.

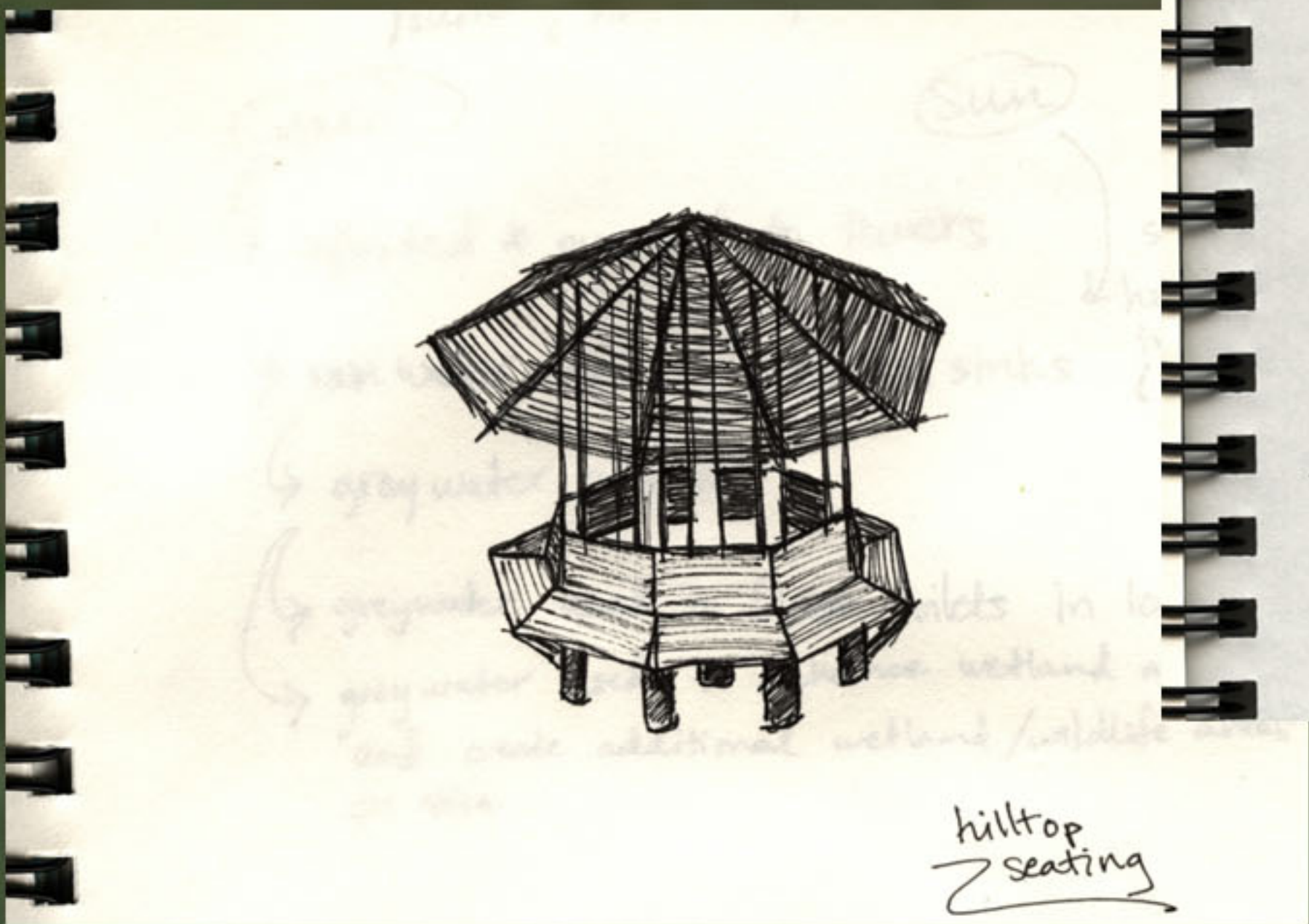


Clay model of topography
